



ZAYO BANDWIDTH TO ADD ADDITIONAL WIRELESS TOWERS TO DEEP FIBER FOOTPRINT

LOUISVILLE, Colo. – June 10, 2010 – Zayo Bandwidth, which couples national, regional and local fiber connections with industry-leading customer service, will expand its high bandwidth capacity fiber-to-tower (FTT) coverage by adding Ethernet and TDM services to wireless tower sites throughout central and Wilkes Barre, PA. The expansion increases the number of FTT customer locations served by Zayo Bandwidth to over 1,700, with another 800 customer locations pending, further strengthening the company's position as a key industry provider of FTT bandwidth solutions.
