



ZAYO GROUP CLARIFIES REFERENCES TO AFS PURCHASE PRICE

LOUISVILLE, Colo. – June 30, 2010 – Zayo Group restated that the terms of its acquisition of American Fiber Systems Holding Corporation (AFS) are not disclosed, but that the \$185-190 million consideration referenced by various media outlets is materially inaccurate and overstated.
