

IP Address Policy

A. Terms. Where Zayo assigns IP addresses ("IP(s)") for use with an underlying IP Services ("Underlying Service"):

- Customer shall use the IPs in accordance with the Zayo IP configuration form and all terms thereon.
- Customer shall use the IPs in accordance with American Registry for Internet Numbers (ARIN) policies, which is available at <http://www.arin.net>.
- Zayo shall retain any assigned public IPs upon termination of Underlying Service.
- Zayo and Customer agree that IPs are "non-portable" and must not be routed or advertised by other Internet Service providers without prior written approval by Zayo.
- Any Customer IPs which are allocated directly from ARIN will be ported/routed by Zayo where reasonably possible; Zayo cannot guarantee the portability/routability of these IPs beyond its own backbone.
- Zayo may, in its sole discretion, reject a request for additional IP assignment where the request fails to comply with Zayo's IP configuration form and/or applicable ARIN policies.
- Zayo reserves the right to modify its Zayo IP configuration form without notice.
- Zayo reserves the right to audit assignments for compliance at any time.

B. Price Escalation. Any increase to IP assignment(s) requested after the execution of the Service Order are subject to applicable MRC listed in the service order while the service is under term. Upon renewal, at Zayo's discretion, the above MRCs are subject to adjustments to reflect current market rates.

C. IP Term. All IP assignment(s) shall have a Service Term that is coterminous with the Underlying Service.

D. Zayo's right to audit - In accordance to Zayo's IP configuration form, in the event that a Zayo initiated audit results in the need to recover underutilized IP address blocks the customer's pricing will be adjusted to reflect the new corresponding block size MRC.
